Make sure to have your dog up-to-date on its rabies vaccination. Contact your vet to discuss your dog's vaccination needs. A rabies vaccination is The Law. And by the way, the park requires a rabies vaccination for all dogs - so no puppies allowed in the park until vaccinated.
