Pilgram Bark Park experiences first dog fatality

Our neighbor park, Pilgrim Bark Park, suffered a sad loss when a large dog out of the blue ran and grabbed a small dog as it entered and inflicted fatal injuries. No warning; no previous behavior issue; two owners trying to stop the attack to no avail. Please remember we are dealing with animals and instinct almost always wins over owner commands. Be ready to leave or throw water in an instant. And remind people to watch their dogs, even when visiting with others!
