We have geared up for the seventh time since we opened in May 2011 to welcome A LOT of dogs and their people. We have tried to spruce up the park, cleaned benches and the bubblers, made sure the drain is clear and working, and stocked up on mutt mitts and waste station liners. We've even picked up cigarette butts, weeded, and sprayed to keep the poison ivy away from you and your dog.

We are happy to tell you about the improvements at the park this year. Some of the students at Falmouth High School designed and painted our new signs along Brick Kiln Road. We will be working over the next few weeks to tidy up the area below the signs. We will celebrate with those students and their teacher at our Art in the Park Day Sunday, June 4 at 1 p.m. Stop by at that time and let them know how much you like their work. We also thank Miller Starbuck Construction for hanging the signs!

We ordered new bubblers because the original ones started to rust. These will be installed sometime this summer when plumber John Maurer and concrete expert Bill Witter can coordinate their schedules.

We also purchased replacement waste containers as the sea air really caused those to rust as well. Two volunteers spent a morning changing those out and we are hopeful people will only use them for bagged dog poop and not coffee cups or other garbage that should be put in the big container



in the entry area.

Remember that when you give to the park, you help keep the park stocked with mutt mitts, waste station liners, paw safe salt for the winter ice, pay for the grass to be cut and snow to be shoveled, weeds and poison ivy to be removed, buy park insurance, add fresh stones and sand, get the driveway regraded as well as pay for the printing of our newsletters and our signage.

You can do your part by volunteering to be a steward (see youtube video listed in left column), weeding when you see the need, sweep the stones off the sidewalks, and especially by donating annually to help maintain the park.
