Each year we ask you to support the park, so let us tell you about the **improvements we were able to make this year** thanks to your 2017 donations, two grants and your Board of Trustees' hard work.

1. We partnered with some of the art students at Falmouth High School who designed and painted our new appeals sign along the walkway.

2. Plumber John Maurer and concrete expert Bill Witter installed new steel bubblers and we replaced the waste bins with stainless steel ones as well.

3. We spruced up the gravel and sand areas with truckloads of materials. And we brought in goats to remove weeds between the fence and Brick Kiln Road. We also combined a spray treatment and brush removal to free the fence area of all the growth.

4. We added new woodchips all along the driveway and had **Bill Witter and Joe Martinho** install a second solar light at the beginning of the walkway from the parking lot.

5. We added a new area for dogs new to the park or for those that might need to be more protected or isolated on a given day.

So that is what your Board of Trustees has done for the dog park users. Have you considered what you can do for the park?

1. Give a donation - remember that when you give to the park, you help keep the park stocked with mutt mitts, waste station liners, paw safe



salt for the winter ice, grass to be cut and snow to be shoveled, weeds and poison ivy to be removed, park insurance, add fresh stones and sand, get the driveway regraded as well as pay for the printing of our newsletters and our signage.

2. Volunteer to be a steward (see youtube video listed in left column). We only ask you to choose one 20 minute slot each month to be part of the team. Or volunteer to help out when we man the tables for the Cape Cod Marathon.

3. Weed when you see the need, sweep the stones off the sidewalks, and pick up poop if you see it.

4. Shop using Smile.Amazon.com and have the dog park benefit from your purchase. Or shop some of the dog park merchandise - hats, teeshirts, and sacks.

Finally, please remember that talking on the phone is no excuse for not supervising your dog while at the park.
